PURSUANT to the Accident Compensation Act 1972, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. **Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Accident Compensation Motor Vehicle Levies Regulations 1973, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Compensation Motor Vehicle Levies Regulations 1973* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. **Further collection fees**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by omitting from regulation 6 (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Accident Compensation Motor Vehicle Levies Regulations 1973, Amendment No. 2) the words “and any subsequent licensing year be 40 cents”, and substituting the words “be 40 cents; and for any subsequent licensing year be 50 cents”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the collection fee payable to the Post Office in respect of every levy that it receives under the motor vehicle accident scheme for the licensing year commencing on 1 July 1976 and any subsequent licensing year.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 24 June 1976.

These regulations are administered by the Accident Compensation Commission.
