THE ARMED FORCES ESTABLISHMENTS ROAD TRAFFIC BYLAWS 1953, AMENDMENT NO. 3

Pursuant to section 72 of the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Defence, being the Minister having the control of the roads within the bounds of the Establishments specified in the Schedule to the principal bylaws, hereby makes the following bylaws.

BYLAWS

- 1. (1) These bylaws may be cited as the Armed Forces Establishments Road Traffic Bylaws 1953, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Armed Forces Establishments Road Traffic Bylaws 1953* (herein referred to as the principal bylaws).
- (2) These bylaws shall come into force on the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. The Schedule to the principal bylaws is hereby amended by omitting the words "Motuihe Island Auckland", and substituting the words "Narrow Neck, Devonport".
