ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 1st day of November 1971

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Animals Quarantine and Import Inspection Fees Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Animals Quarantine and Import Inspection Fees Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Veterinary, inspection, and supervision fees for sheep—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 4, the following regulation:

“4A. Notwithstanding anything in regulation 4 of these regulations, the fees payable for the examination, inspection, and supervision in respect of sheep imported into New Zealand on or after the 1st day of December 1970 and not quarantined shall be computed at the following rates:

For one sheep	\$ 4.00
For each additional sheep up to 20, the property of the same owner	1.00
For each 10, and such number as may be less than 10, additional sheep over 20 and up to 100, the property of the same owner	3.00
For each 10, and such number as may be less than 10, additional sheep over 100, the property of the same owner	2.00”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations reduce the rates at which fees for the examination, inspection, and supervision of sheep imported into New Zealand on or after 1 December 1970 and not quarantined are payable.
