



THE CONTROLLED FISHERIES (GISBORNE ROCK LOBSTER FISHERY) NOTICE 1980, AMENDMENT NO. 3

PURSUANT TO section 118 of the Fisheries Act 1908, the Minister of Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Controlled Fisheries (Gisborne Rock Lobster Fishery) Notice 1980, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Controlled Fisheries (Gisborne Rock Lobster Fishery) Notice 1980* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Maximum number of licences reduced—(1) Clause 3 of the principal notice is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2) (as added by clause 2 of the Controlled Fisheries (Gisborne Rock Lobster Fishery) Notice 1980, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the following subclause:

“(2) The maximum number of licences that may be granted by the Fisheries Licensing Authority in respect of the Gisborne rock lobster fishery is hereby fixed at 85.”

(2) The Controlled Fisheries (Gisborne Rock Lobster Fishery) Notice 1980, Amendment No. 2 is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
