Pursuant to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Economic Stabilisation Regulations 1973, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Economic Stabilisation Regulations 1973* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Exempted goods and services—The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from clause 3 the words "other than sheepmeats covered by price order".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The effect of these regulations is that all fresh or frozen meat will be exempted from the price freeze provisions in Part II of the principal regulations. Previously, sheepmeat covered by price orders was excluded from the general exemption of fresh or frozen meat.
