**THE FACTORIES CONSOLIDATING REGULATIONS 1937,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 11th day of
August, 1948

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Factories Act, 1946, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day following the date of notification thereof in the *Gazette*.

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the heading "Offences and Penalties" and the regulation numbered 24 thereunder, and substituting the following new heading and regulation :—

" REGISTER OF ACCIDENTS

" 25. The register of accidents to be kept by the occupier of a factory under section 17 of the Factories Act, 1946, shall be in the form F.-18 set out in the Second Schedule hereto, and shall contain the particulars set out therein."

4. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following new form :—

“ [Form F.—18

“ *Under the Factories Act, 1946 (Section 17)*

“ ACCIDENT REGISTER

“ (To be filled in by the occupier of the factory in respect of every accident which occurs in the factory and of which he has knowledge)

“ Date of Occurrence.	Time of Occurrence.	Name of Injured Person.	Place, Department, Machine (or as case may be) where Accident occurred.	Cause of Accident.	Nature of Injuries.”
