**THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (CIGARETTE-PAPERS  
MANUFACTURE) AMENDMENT NOTICE, 1939.**

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, I, Daniel Giles Sullivan, Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby give notice as follows :—

1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Cigarette-papers Manufacture) Amendment Notice 1939.

2. The Industry Licensing (Cigarette-papers Manufacture) Notice 1938\* (hereinafter called the principal notice) is amended by revoking paragraph 3 thereof, and substituting the following :—

“ 3. For the purposes of this notice the manufacture of cigarette-papers shall be deemed to include the cutting or packing or cutting and packing of paper wrappers which are intended to be used for tobacco in the form of cigarettes, and which are intended to be sold or otherwise disposed of as wrappers separately from manufactured cigarettes, and shall be deemed to include such manufacture, whether with or without other processes, but apart from the manufacture of the paper so cut and packed.”

3. Except as modified by this notice, the principal notice shall continue in full force and effect.
