“New Zealand Venture Investment Fund”.
- (5) Part II of the First Schedule of the Ombudsmen Act 1975 is amended by omitting the item relating to Valuation New Zealand.
- (6) Part II of the First Schedule of the Ombudsmen Act 1975 is amended by inserting, in its appropriate alphabetical order, the following item:
“Quotable Value New Zealand Limited”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 January 2003, amends the First Schedule of the Ombudsmen Act 1975. References to departments and organisations that no longer exist are omitted. Amendments are also made to reflect changes of name for certain organisations.

In addition, New Zealand Venture Investment Limited, which is a new Crown company, is added to Part II of the First Schedule.
