HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Southern Lakes Fishing Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Southern Lakes Fishing Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (d) the words "to be issued only to male persons sixteen years of age and over".

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Third Schedule, and substituting the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*]

These regulations revoke the provision that monthly fishing licences in the Southern Lakes Acclimatization District may be issued only to male persons sixteen years of age and over, and substitute a new Schedule of licence fees, the only changes being that the Schedule increases the fees for whole season licences and now prescribes a fee for monthly licences issued to women or girls or boys under sixteen years of age.
