



**THE SHIPPING (CERTIFICATES OF COMPETENCY AS A.B.)
REGULATIONS 1954, AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 204 of the Maritime Transport Act 1994, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Shipping (Certificates of Competency as A.B.) Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping (Certificates of Competency as A.B.) Regulations 1954* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1995.

2. Prescribed dates—(1) Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclauses (1) and (2) the words “or in any home trade ship (whether a New Zealand ship or not)”.

(2) Regulation 3 (3) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “or any home trade ship (whether a New Zealand ship or not)”.

3. Revocations—(1) Regulation 5A of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Shipping (Certificates of Competency as A.B.) Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 1) is hereby revoked.

(2) The principal regulations are hereby consequentially amended—

(a) By omitting from regulation 4 (1) the expression “regulations 5 and 5A” (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Shipping (Certificates of Competency as A.B.) Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the expression “regulation 5”;

(b) By omitting from regulation 5 the words “Subject to the provisions of regulation 5A of these regulations, and” (as so substituted).

(3) The Shipping (Certificates of Competency as A.B.) Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 February 1995, amend the Shipping (Certificates of Competency as A.B.) Regulations 1954 by removing from the scope of those regulations certificates relating to home trade ships. The amendment aligns those regulations with the Maritime Transport Act 1994 and recognises that foreign ships may operate in the coastal trade with certificates accepted or recognised by the Director of Maritime Safety and need not hold New Zealand certificates.
