THE RIGHT HON. N. E. KIRK PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Sale of Liquor Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. **Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Sale of Liquor Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Sale of Liquor Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. **Returns by holders of hotelkeepers' and tourist-house keepers' licences**—Regulation 41 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1) the words "one month", and substituting the words "3 months".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 41 of the Sale of Liquor Regulations 1963 requires the holder of every hotelkeeper's or tourist-house keeper's licence to file a return with the Licensing Control Commission within 1 month after the 31st day of March in each year. These regulations extend from 1 month to 3 months the period within which those returns may be filed so that they will now be required to be filed not later than the 30th day of June in each year.
