

(1178.) CANTERBURY MALTSTERS AND BREWERY EMPLOYEES.—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration, Canterbury District (Christchurch).—
In the matter of “ The Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1905,” and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 16th day of October, 1906, made between the Canterbury Maltsters and Brewery Employees’ Industrial Union of Workers and the several employers therein mentioned; and in the matter of an application for amendment thereof.

ORDER OF COURT AMENDING AWARD.

THE Court, being satisfied that the latter part of clause 1 of the above-mentioned award regulating the hours of brewery nightmen, which reads “ Brewery nightmen’s hours of labour shall be five hours per day on

five days of the week, to start at such time as suits the firm," does not express the agreement arrived at by the parties, doth hereby order that it be deleted from the said award, and that the following words be inserted in place thereof: "Brewery nightmen's hours shall be eight hours on five days of the week, and five hours on one day of the week, to start at such time as suits the firm."
