

(1148.) NEW ZEALAND FEDERATED BOOT TRADE.—PARTY ADDED
TO AWARD (OAMARU).

In the Court of Arbitration, Otago and Southland District (Dunedin).
—In the matter of an award made the 21st day of November, 1905, between the New Zealand Federated Boot Trade Association of Workmen and the New Zealand Boot-manufacturers' Industrial Union of Employers; and in the matter of a dispute between the Dunedin Operative Bootmakers' Industrial Union of Workers and James McDiarmid, of Oamaru, boot-manufacturer, and of a reference thereof for settlement.

ORDER OF COURT EXTENDING AWARD.

THE Court having heard the application to join the said James McDiarmid to and bind him by the above-mentioned award dated the 21st day of November, 1905, doth hereby order that the said James McDiarmid be made a party to the said award and be bound as from the 1st day of November, 1906, subject to the condition that he shall be bound by the said award only as regards the manufacturing portion of his business, and not as regards the repairing portion.
