

(4569.) INVERCARGILL DRIVERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 28th day of October, 1916, made in an industrial dispute between the Southland Building Trade and General Labourers, Wool and Grain Store Employees, Gasworks Employees, and Drivers' Industrial Union of Workers and W. Anderson and others.

Saturday, the 17th day of February, 1917.

By virtue of section 92, subsection (1) (a), of the said Act, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the said award, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended by inserting in the first line of clause 4 (c) thereof, after the word "bakers," the words "or retail shopkeepers."

This order shall take effect as from the 27th day of November, 1916.
