

(5007.) NORTHERN DISTRICT (EXCEPT GISBORNE JUDICIAL DISTRICT) TINSMITHS AND SHEET-METAL WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 15th day of December, 1916, made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Branch of the Amalgamated Society of Engineers' (including Brass-finishers, Tinsmiths, and Sheet-metal Workers) Industrial Union of Workers and Edward Adams and others.

Saturday, the 21st day of September, 1918.

UPON the application of the above-named union, and after hearing the representatives of the said union and of the employers parties to the said award, and by virtue of the power reserved to the Court by clause 5, subclause (*d*), of the said award, this Court doth order that the said award be and the same is hereby amended by deleting subclause (*c*) of clause 5 thereof.

This order shall take effect from the 30th day of September, 1918.
