

(6547.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (EXCEPT POVERTY BAY) BUILDERS' LABOURERS.—ORDER STRIKING OUT PARTY TO AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of an award dated the 10th day of May, 1920 (Book of Awards, Vol. xxi, p. 425), made in an industrial dispute between the Auckland Builders' General Labourers' Industrial Union of Workers and the Auckland Builders and Contractors' Industrial Union of Employers and others, and amended by an order adding parties and dated the 16th day of February, 1921.
