

(7168.) NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (EXCEPT GISBORNE JUDICIAL DISTRICT) CLEANERS, CARETAKERS, AND LIFTMEN.—ORDER ADDING PARTIES TO AWARD.
