

(7504.) SOUTH CANTERBURY WOOL, GRAIN, HIDE, AND MANURE STORES EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and its amendments; and in the matter of the South Canterbury Wool, Grain, Hide, and Manure Stores Employees' award, dated the 14th day of December, 1922, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxiii, p. 1215.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section 92 of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in and giving fuller meaning to clause 4 of the South Canterbury Wool, Grain, Hide and Manure Stores Employees' award, dated the 14th day of December, 1922, and recorded in Book of Awards, Vol. xxiii, p. 1215, this Court, being of the opinion that it is just and equitable to amend the said award, doth hereby order that the said award shall be amended in manner following, that is to say—

1. Subclause (a) of clause 4 of the said award shall be deleted and the following provision substituted therefor:—

“(a.) All time worked between 6 p.m. and 10 p.m. and between 6.30 a.m. and 8 a.m. shall be paid for at time-and-a-third rates. All time worked between 12 noon and 6 p.m. on Saturdays shall be paid for at time-and-a-third rates. All time worked between 10 p.m. and 6.30 a.m. shall be paid for at double-time rates.”

2. This order shall be deemed to have operated and taken effect as from the 1st day of December, 1922.
