

AUCKLAND (TWENTY-MILE RADIUS) **MILK-ROUNDSMEN.**—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Auckland (Twenty-mile Radius) Milk-roundsmen's award, dated the 13th day of November, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 936.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Auckland (Twenty-mile Radius) Milk-roundsmen's award, dated the 13th day of November, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 936, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended—

(i) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) All roundsmen shall be paid the minimum wage of £5 10s. per week. Relieving roundsmen shall be paid 7s. per week extra.”

(ii) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 7 (Work not provided for), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) All work done by any roundsman other than retailing milk, cleansing cans used by him, keeping such reasonable accounts and books of accounts in connection with his round, and the proper care of horse, harness, and/or vehicle used by him shall be considered overtime work and shall be paid for at 2s. 10½d. per hour.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
