

AMENDMENT OF INTERIM GENERAL APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Interim General Apprenticeship Order, dated the 30th day of December, 1924, and recorded in 25 Book of Awards 1634.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Apprentices Act, 1923, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the orders, specified in the following schedule, amending the Interim General Apprenticeship Order, dated the 30th day of

December, 1924, and recorded in 25 Book of Awards 1634, shall be amended by revoking the declaration contained in clause 2 of each of the said orders, and substituting therefor the following provision :—

*“Exclusion from Operation of General Orders*

“The amended rates of remuneration provided for in this order shall *not* be subject to the provisions of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations, 1940, and dated the 9th day of August, 1940, and the 31st day of March, 1942.”
