

AUCKLAND AND WELLINGTON FIRE BRIGADES' OFFICERS—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Auckland and Wellington Fire Brigades' Officers' award, dated the 17th day of September, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 1121 (in force in respect of Wellington Fire Board only).

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the association of workers party to the Auckland and Wellington Fire Brigades' Officers' award, dated the 17th day of September, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 1121, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 9th day of May, 1949) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 1 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum rate of wages to be paid to the several grades of officers shall be as follows:—

“ Fourth officers	10	1	3
“ Third officers	10	13	3”

(2) By deleting subclause (b) of clause 1 (Wages).

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
