

CHRISTCHURCH CITY COUNCIL GARDENERS AND LABOURERS—VARIATION
OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

THIS industrial agreement made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, this 14th day of March 1957, between the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the City of Christchurch a corporation constituted under the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, and hereinafter referred to as "the corporation", and joining in these presents as an employer, of the one part, and the Canterbury General and Builders' Labourers' and Related Workers' Industrial Union of Workers, an industrial union registered under the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, and hereinafter referred to as "the industrial union" (the registered office of which union is situated at 194 Gloucester Street, in the City of Christchurch) of the other part, witnesseth that it is mutually agreed by and between the said parties that this industrial agreement shall vary the industrial agreement made on the 8th day of October 1956, between the corporation of the one part and the union of the other part, to the extent hereinafter set forth:

Delete clause 11 and substitute the following:

The rates of remuneration set out in this agreement which are inclusive of the general order of the Court of Arbitration dated 28 October 1954, are increased by 4.425 per cent from the 19th day of November 1956, provided that such increase shall not exceed 15s. 7d. per week in the case of adult male workers, 11s. 8d. per week in the case of adult female workers or 8s. 10d. in the case of junior workers and provided further that such increase shall not apply to allowances in respect of tools, bicycles, motor vehicles, protective or special clothing or special footwear.
