

**AUCKLAND TOTALISATOR EMPLOYEES—AMENDMENT OF AGREEMENT
UNDER LABOUR DISPUTES INVESTIGATION ACT 1913**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, and the Economic Stabilisation Regulations 1953; and in the matter of the Auckland Totalisator Employees' Agreement under the Labour Disputes Investigation Act 1913, dated the 19th day of August 1958, and recorded in 58 Book of Awards 1341.

UPON reading the application made by the parties to the Auckland Totalisator Employees' Agreement under the Labour Disputes Investigation Act 1913, dated the 19th day of August 1958, and recorded in 58 Book of Awards 1341, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on it by regulation 4 of the Economic Stabilisation Regulations 1953 and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said agreement shall be amended by deleting clause 1 and substituting therefor the following clause:

All employees classified in Schedule 2 shall be paid a cash handling risk allowance of 5s. 3d. per day.

Where payers are required to pay doubles in addition to win and place dividends they shall be paid the sum of 2s. 6d. extra for each and every double race so paid.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 12th day of October 1959.
