AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, and the Economic Stabilisation Regulations 1953; and in the matter of the Auckland Launch and Towboat Company Ltd. Marine Engine-drivers Industrial Agreement, dated the 25th day of June 1956, and recorded in 56 Book of Awards 1023.

UPON reading the application made on behalf of the parties to the Auckland Launch and Towboat Co. Ltd. Marine Engine-drivers Industrial Agreement, dated the 25th day of June 1956, and recorded in 56 Book of Awards 1023, the Court in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on it by regulation 4 of the Economic Stabilisation Regulations 1953, and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said agreement shall be amended by deleting the symbols and figures “£12 0s. 0d.” where they appear in clauses 2 and 3 and substituting “£13 8s.”.

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 12th day of October 1959.
