Ltd., proprietors of the *Northern Advocate*, Waikato and King Country Press Ltd., proprietors of the *Waikato Times*, and the Bay of Plenty Times Ltd., proprietors of the *Bay of Plenty Times*, on the other part, is mutually agreed by and between the said parties to be varied with effect from the 8th day of September, 1966.
