AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1938.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1945*.* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1938*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1945*.

2. Section four of the *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1938* is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words "The Assistant Secretary (Canberra Services), Department of the Interior" and inserting in their stead the words "An officer of the Department of Works and Housing appointed by the Minister of State for Works and Housing to be a member of the Council". Constitution of Advisory Council.
