An Ordinance to amend the Architects Ordinance 1959

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Architects (Amendment) Ordinance 1982.¹

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Architects Ordinance 1959.²

Mode of registration

3. Section 15 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (3) "Ten dollars" and substituting "\$25".

Practising certificate

4. Section 18A of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1) "Ten dollars" and substituting "\$20".
