AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Cemeteries Ordinance 1933.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Cemeteries Ordinance 1942*.*

Short title and citation.

(2) The *Cemeteries Ordinance 1933*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Cemeteries Ordinance 1933-1942*.

2. Section five of the *Cemeteries Ordinance 1933* is amended by omitting paragraph (c) of sub-section (1.) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—

Provision of public cemeteries according to religious denominations, &c.

“(c) for the burial of deceased persons who served—

- (i) in the war which commenced in the year One thousand nine hundred and fourteen, in any Naval or Military Expeditionary Force raised in the Commonwealth or in any other part of the King's dominions; or
- (ii) in any other war in which His Majesty is or has been engaged—

(1) in the Naval, Military or Air Forces of the Commonwealth or of any other part of the King's dominions; or

(2) in the Commonwealth or any Territory of the Commonwealth or in any area adjacent thereto, in the Armed Forces of any Power or Authority allied or associated with His Majesty in any such war.”.
