An Ordinance to amend the Flammable Liquids Ordinance 1976

# Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Flammable Liquids (Amendment) Ordinance 1981.<sup>1</sup>

## Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Flammable Liquids Ordinance 1976.<sup>2</sup>

### Precautions to be observed in handling flammable liquid

3. Section 20c of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:

"(6) The occupier of premises shall not knowingly permit a person who is on the premises to contravene this section.

Penalty: \$500.".

#### **Repeal of section 20D**

4. Section 20D of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.
