An Ordinance to amend the *Flammable Liquids Ordinance 1976*

**Short title**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Flammable Liquids (Amendment) Ordinance 1981*.<sup>1</sup>

**Principal Ordinance**

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Flammable Liquids Ordinance 1976*.<sup>2</sup>

**Precautions to be observed in handling flammable liquid**

3. Section 20c of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:

"(6) The occupier of premises shall not knowingly permit a person who is on the premises to contravene this section.

Penalty: \$500."

**Repeal of section 20D**

4. Section 20D of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.
