MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS REGISTRATION ORDINANCE 1973

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance* 1973.* Short title
and citation.

(2) The *Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance* 1930-1970,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance* 1930-1973.

2. Section 38A of the *Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance* 1930-1970 is amended by omitting from sub-section (3) the words "Canberra Community Hospital" and substituting the words "Canberra Hospital or the Woden Valley Hospital". Appointment
