Act No. 44, 1978.

An Act to provide for the holding of a referendum upon the Bill entitled "A Bill for an Act to provide for the election of Members of the Legislative Council directly by the people" and to repeal the Constitution (Referendum) Act, 1977. [Assented to, 29th March, 1978.]

Constitution (Referendum).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Constitution (Referendum) Act, 1978".

Repeal of Act No. 58, 1977. **2.** The Constitution (Referendum) Act, 1977, is repealed.

Referendum to be held on the 1978 reconstitution Bill.

3. (1) The Bill entitled "A Bill for an Act to provide for the election of Members of the Legislative Council directly by the people" as finally passed through both Houses of the Legislature on 8th March, 1978, shall be submitted by way of referendum to the electors qualified to vote for the election of Members of the Legislative Assembly.

(2) The day appointed for the taking of the votes of the electors at the referendum is 17th June, 1978.

(3) The referendum shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution Further Amendment (Referendum) Act, 1930.
