FARMERS' RELIEF (AMEND-MENT) ACT.

Act No. 25, 1938.

An Act to amend the Farmers' Relief Act, 1932, George VI. and certain other Acts in certain respects, to validate certain matters; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 12th December, 1938.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Farmers' Relief Short title (Amendment) Act, 1938."

(2) The Farmers' Relief Act, 1932-1937, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

- (3) The Principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Farmers' Relief Act, 1932-1938.
- 2. (1) The Principal Act is amended by omitting from Amendment subsection one of section eight the word "thirty-eight" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "forty."

(2) Subsection one of this section shall be deemed (Stay to have commenced on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight.

3. (1) No amendment of the Farmers' Relief Act, Parties to 1932, made by any subsequent Act (including this Act) certain bends shall be held to operate or to have operated so as to not to be release any party or surety to any bond executed and released. delivered to the Farmers' Relief Board in pursuance of section thirteen of that Act, whether as originally enacted or as amended from time to time.

(2) A reference in any such bond executed before the commencement of this Act to the Farmers' Relief Act.
