SUPPLY ACT.

Act No. 11, 1924.

George V, An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1924-1925, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 3rd October, 1924.]

Prea able.; WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Three millions one hundred and seventy-five thousand and fifty pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund the sum of Two millions two hundred and seventy-seven thousand pounds, being the sum required

required to defray the expenses of the various George V, Departments and Services of the State during the month of October or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five.

- Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of Seventeen thousand three hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule Λ hereto annexed.
- Out of the General Loan Account, the sum of Eight hundred and eighty thousand seven hundred and fifty pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule B hereto annexed:

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds and the General Loan Account the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

- 1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New £2,277,000 South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied may be issued for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be Consolidated granted to His Majesty, the sum of Two millions two Revenue Fund. hundred and seventy-seven thousand pounds, to be expended at the rates which are shown on the Estimates for the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, as laid upon the Table of the House, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of October, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, subject to the rate of any reduction that may be reafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1924-1925.
- 2. Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and £17,300 may may be issued and applied for or towards making good be issued out of the Public the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, Works Fund. the sum of Seventeen thousand three hundred pounds for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.

George V, No. 11. £880,750 may be issued out of the General Loan Account.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Audit Act, 1902, there shall and may be issued out of the General Loan Account and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Eight hundred and eighty thousand seven hundred and fifty pounds for the Services specified in Schedule B hereto annexed.

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order. 4. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works Fund and the General Loan Account respectively.

Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.

5. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

Short title.

6. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act, 1924."
