After Part 5, rule 11, insert:

Division 2A Proceedings commenced by summons

11A Application and Procedure

- (1) This Division applies to proceedings commenced by summons.
- (2) For the purposes of Division 1 of Part 5, a Summons is an originating process.

Amendments Schedule 1

(3) The procedure for the hearing and disposal of a Summons shall be as near as practicable to that applicable to the hearing and disposal of a notice of motion in accordance with the provisions of Part 14 (2), (3), (4) and (5).

11B Particular proceedings commenced by summons

- (1) Proceedings under section 52B(1) of the *Workers Compensation Act* 1987 shall be commenced by the filing of a Summons.
- (2) Proceedings under sections 52B(3), (6) and (8) of the *Workers Compensation Act 1987* shall be commenced by way of notice of motion in the proceedings to which the application relates.
