EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this proclamation is to commence Schedule 11 to the *Courts Legislation Amendment Act 1998*. Schedule 11 substitutes section 32 of the *Dust Diseases Tribunal Act 1989*, which relates to appeals to the supreme court from decisions of the Dust Diseases Tribunal, and inserts a savings and transitional provision into Schedule 3 (Savings, transitional and other provisions) to the *Dust Diseases Tribunals Act 1989*
