NATIONAL PARKS AND GARDENS (DALY RIVER RECREATION RESERVE) BY-LAWS

- Citation 1. These By-laws may be cited as the National Parks and Gardens (Daly River Recreation Reserve) By-laws.
 - Definitions 2. In these By-laws, "the Reserve" means the land that was committed to the care, control and management of the Board by notice in *Northern Territory Government Gazette* No. 21 of 1967 dated 5 April, 1967.
 - Fires 3. A person shall not light a wood fire on the Reserve except in—
 - (a) a fireplace provided by the Board; or
 - (b) an area that has been set aside by the Board as an area where wood fires are permitted.
- Penalty: One hundred dollars.
