An Act to amend the Apprentices Act, 1950-1966.

[Assented to 20th October, 1966.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Apprentices Act Amendment Act, 1966".

(2) The Apprentices Act, 1950-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Apprentices Act, 1950-1966".

(3) The Apprentices Act, 1950-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 18—

Duty of apprentice to attend technical schools and of employer to permit him to attend.

3. Subsection (4) of section 18 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the word "but" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "and that" ;

and

(b) by inserting after the word "apprenticeship" where it secondly occurs therein the passage "and during the third year of an apprenticeship".

4. Section 27 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "employer" in subsection (4) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the word "person".
