An Act to amend the Juries Act, 1917.

[*Assented to, October 5th, 1921.*]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Juries Act Amendment Act, 1921." Short titles.
- (2) The Juries Act, 1917, and this Act may be cited together as the "Juries Acts, 1917 and 1921." No. 1290 of 1917.
- (3) The Juries Act, 1917, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act."
2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act, and that Act and this Act shall be read together as one Act. Incorporation with principal Act.
3. Subsection (3) of section 136 of the principal Act is amended—
Amendment of principal Act, s. 136 (3)—
 - (a) by substituting for the words "Ten Shillings" the words "Twelve Shillings and Six Pence"; and Fees payable at time of application for jury.
 - (b) by adding at the end thereof the following passage:—
"and also a sum equal to the total of the sums due to every such juror in respect of mileage for such day."
4. Subsection (2) of section 137 of the principal Act is amended—Amendment of principal Act, s. 137 (2)—
 - (a) by substituting for the words "Ten Shillings" the words "Twelve Shillings and Six Pence"; and Fees in Matrimonial Causes.
 - (b) by

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following passage:—
 “and also a sum equal to the total of the sums due to every such juror in respect of mileage for such day.”
