An Act to amend the Legal Practitioners Act, 1981.

[Assented to 10 December 1987]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Legal Practitioners Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1987". Short title.

(2) The Legal Practitioners Act, 1981, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 16 of the principal Act is amended by inserting in subsection (5) "and levy" after "fee". Amendment of s. 16—
Issue of practising certificate.

3. Section 95 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection: Amendment of s. 95—
Application of certain revenues.

(1a) The revenue raised from practising certificate levies will be applied for the purpose of maintaining and improving the Supreme Court library.

4. Section 97 of the principal Act is amended by inserting in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) "or levy" after "fee". Amendment of s. 97—
Regulations.
