## No. 1410.

An Act to amend the Mining Act Amendment Act, 1904,  
and for other purposes.

[*Assented to, November 27th, 1919.*]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia,  
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as  
follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Mining Act Further Amendment Act, 1919." Short titles.

(2) The Mining Acts, 1893 to 1918, and this Act may be cited together as the "Mining Acts, 1893 to 1919."

(3) The Mining Act, 1893, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act." No. 587 of 1893.

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation with other Acts.

3. Section 2 of the Mining Act Amendment Act, 1904, is amended—  
(a) by inserting "and Part VII." after "Part IV." in the first line thereof; and  
(b) by substituting the word "Parts" for the word "Part" in the third line thereof. Amendment of Act 858, 1904, s. 2—  
Certain provisions of Mining Act to apply to quarries.

4. Part XI. of the Regulations made under the principal Act on the twenty-eighth day of February, 1894, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the first day of March, 1894 (excepting the special Certain regulations under Mining Acts to apply to quarries.

special rules for coal mines contained therein), and the regulations under the principal Act made on the twenty-eighth day of August, 1907, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the twenty-ninth day of August, 1907, shall until revoked, and subject to any alterations made therein by Regulations heretofore or hereafter made under the principal Act, apply to all such quarries as mentioned in section 2 of the Mining Act Amendment Act, 1904.
