An Act to amend the Margarine Act, 1939-1940.

[Assented to 27th November, 1941.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Margarine Act Amendment Act, 1941".

(2) The Margarine Act, 1939-1940, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Margarine Act, 1939-1941".

(3) The Margarine Act, 1939-1940, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act, and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of heading.

3. The heading appearing before section 20 of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after the word "Manufacture" the words "and Sale".

Amendment of s. 20 of the principal Act—Control of the amount of margarine to be manufactured.

4. (1) Section 20 of the principal Act is amended by striking out in the fourth and fifth lines of subsection (3) thereof the words "otherwise consents be not less than" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "agrees to a smaller quantity be".

(2) Section 20 is further amended by inserting after subsection (3) thereof the following subsection :—

(3a) The Minister shall not by declarations made under this section permit to be manufactured in any calendar year—

- (a) during the present war a greater aggregate quantity of table margarine than two hundred and sixty tons ;
- (b) after the present war a greater aggregate quantity of table margarine than three hundred and twelve tons.

For the purposes of this subsection the present war shall be deemed to continue until the end of the calendar year in which that war ends.

5. Section 25 of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after paragraph (c) the following paragraphs :—

Amendment of s. 25 of the principal Act—  
Regulations.

- (c1) for prescribing the ingredients to be used in the manufacture of table margarine :
- (c2) regulating or forbidding the sale of table margarine not containing the prescribed ingredients :
- (c3) providing for the inspection in the State of the ingredients used in the manufacture of table margarine sold or intended to be sold in the State :
- (c4) forbidding the sale of table margarine which does not comply with the regulations as to wholesomeness and freedom from adulteration or the ingredients of which have not been inspected in accordance with the regulations.

6. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 25 thereof :—

Enactment of s. 25a of principal Act—

25a. Every provision of this Act relating to—

Application of Act to table margarine.

- (a) the entry and search of any place where table margarine or any fats, oils, or other substance commonly used in the manufacture of table margarine are suspected to be stored, packed, or sold ;
- (b) the inspection and obtaining samples of any such table margarine or other substance ;
- (c) the inspection and making copies of and taking extracts from any accounts, books, or documents relating to table margarine or any such substance ;
- (d) the securing of information as to table margarine or any such substance ;
- (e) the sale and having in possession for sale of any table margarine or other such substance ;

(f) the ingredients of table margarine ;

(g) the making of regulations,

shall apply in relation to all table margarine and every such other substance in the State irrespective of whether that table margarine or other substance was or was not manufactured in the State.
