An Act to amend the Pistol Licence Act, 1929-1965.

[Assented to 4th May, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Pistol Licence Act Amendment Act, 1971".

(2) The Pistol Licence Act, 1929-1965, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Pistol Licence Act, 1929-1971".

(3) The Pistol Licence Act, 1929-1965, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—
Penalty for carrying unlicensed pistol.

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by inserting in paragraph (a) of subsection (3) after the word "rifle" the passage "or pistol".
