An Act to amend the Police Regulation Act,  
1952-1963, as amended.

[Assented to 10th November, 1966.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Police Regulation Act Amendment Act, 1966". Short titles.
- (2) The Police Regulation Act, 1952-1963, as amended by the Statutes Amendment (Public Salaries) Act, 1963, the Statutes Amendment (Public Salaries) Act, 1964, the Statutes Amendment (Public Salaries) Act, 1965 and by this Act, may be cited as the "Police Regulation Act, 1952-1966".
- (3) The Police Regulation Act, 1952-1963, as amended, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.
3. Subsection (3) of section 11 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage ", grade or class in the detective police, or to any rank above senior constable" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "above senior constable first grade". Amendment of principal Act, s. 11—Appointment of sergeants and constables.

4. The principal Act is amended by striking out every passage therein referring to an amount of money in terms of the currency provided for by the *Coinage Act* 1909-1947, of the Commonwealth and inserting in lieu thereof in each case a passage referring to and representing an amount of money in terms of the currency provided for by the *Currency Act* 1965, of the Commonwealth calculated on the basis of the equivalents specified in subsection (4) of section 8 of that Act.
