AN ACT to amend the Permanent Reserves Act, 1899.

[Assented to, 19th February, 1902.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited as the Permanent Reserves Amendment Act, 1902.

Short title.

2. THE Permanent Reserves Act, 1899, is hereby amended by striking out the words "classified as Class B or Class C" in section three of the said Act.
