AN ACT to amend the Road Districts Act, 1919-1939, by adding a paragraph to section two hundred and four thereof.

[Assented to 15th December, 1941.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Road Districts Act Amendment Act (No. 3)*, 1941, and shall be read as one with the Road Districts Act, 1919-1939, hereinafter called the principal Act.

Amendment of s. 204 of the principal Act.

Parking of caravans, etc.

2. Section two hundred and four of the principal Act is amended by adding a paragraph as follows:—

(61) For prohibiting or regulating the parking or allowing to remain stationary on any land of any caravan or vehicle designed or fitted as a habitation for any person or capable of being used for dwelling or sleeping purposes with-

out the written license of the board; and authorising the granting by the board of licenses for such period or periods and upon such terms as the board may from time to time determine.

3. The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Road Districts Act, 1919-1941.
